MATERIAL	LASER	CNC ROUTER
SOLID WOOD*	Cut up to 1/4" thick	✓
PLYWOOD*	✓	<b>✓</b>
MDF	Glues in MDF can melt, catch fire, and will damage the lasers	Creates excessive dust - mask recommended
ACRYLIC	Cut up to 1/4" thick**	✓
POLYCARBONATE	Releases toxic fumes	Plastics off-gas when cut Vapor respirator recommended
FOAM	Releases toxic fumes, fire risk ^(see note)	✓
COATED / ANODIZED METALS	Etching only, do not use Cermark	Aluminum only ***
UNCOATED METALS	Etching only, must use Cermark	Aluminum only ***
PAPER / CARDBOARD	Clean frequently, paper scraps can catch fire	N/A
STONE	Etching only, use high power	See note***
LEATHER	Leather tanning may affect the cut quality and fumes	N/A
GLASS	Etching only, do not use high power, glass will crack	$\bigcirc$
FABRIC	High power not recommended, NO carbon fiber, pleather, or flame-retardant materials	N/A
CERAMIC	Etching only, do not use high power ceramic will break	
CORK	Only thin cork will cut well	<b>✓</b>

<sup>^</sup> No PVC, PVB, PTFE, Teflon, Epoxy, or Resin can be cut with the laser cutter.

<sup>\*</sup> NO PRESSURE TREATED LUMBER is allowed in the lab.

<sup>\*\*</sup> acrylic from hardware stores is actually polycarbonate, which is not allowed for use with the lasers.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>You must have prior experiencing milling aluminum (or stone) in order to use the ShopBot to do so. You will need to supply your own bit, spoilboard, and cooling / lubrication medium (such as oil). Remember: the ShopBot requires constant supervision to prevent accidents and failures.
